The ESG workstream kicked off its programme with a hiss and a roar in Canterbury with a session titled "Do we care about Carbon, post election?"

We focused on carbon and how development Life Cycle Assessments can help drive carbon out of our developments while maintaining the value proposition. The panel discussion, which included Katie Symons from MBIE, was a great way to discuss the challenges with the new Government mood on what role regulation might play in New Zealand's approach to carbon counting in property and infrastructure.

As with all our content we aim to achieve 2 key things:

- Always provide content that is relevant to our membership whether that be a current challenge or opportunity to grow.
- Always ensure meaningful outputs are generated from workstream events.

Regional Networking Events




